

GENERAL INFORMATION

Wi -Fi ACCESS

- There are **two (2)** options for wi-fi access.
 1. You can use **Eduroam** which is the secure, world-wide roaming access service developed for the international research and education community but you will have to configure your device to enable eduroam access.
 2. Any available university wi-fi that your device will find at the main venue amphitheater with the following credentials:
Username : **guestgeo**
Password: **Pass_Temp!**
- You can also use the lab rooms of the University Hill at the:
 - building of the Department of Geography (2nd floor)
 - building of the Department of the Environment (ground floor).

ATM

- There is an ATM at the University Hill at the ground floor of the Administration Building (on the way from the building of the Environment to the Geography building).

TRANSPORT to and from the UNIVERSITY HILL

BUS

There is frequent bus service (Bus sign «ΠΑΝΕΠΙΣΤΗΜΙΟ») linking the town center (Sapfous Square or “Platia Sapfous” to Greek) to the University Hill (every half hour from 8.30 to 21.00). ***An extra bus is scheduled at 8.15 especially for the Conference.*** The buses depart from the University Hill to the town center 10’ later. ***Use your conference name tag for free transportation (only for this itinerary).***

- There is bus service from the airport to the town center (and vice-versa almost every hour) that stops close to the University Hill.

TAXIS

- You can take a taxi from different places of the town. Taxis are often parked in front of the building of the Department of Environment. You can also call for a taxi to the no: +30 22510 23500 or use Taxiplon mobile App (call center 18222).
